Below is additional important information:

- TK & Kinders will have early release at 11:05 am on 8/16 through 8/19.
- Classroom assignments will be posted in the front office on the glass and on signs on the Llagas side of the school at 4:00 pm on August 12, 2022. The Home and School Club will be hosting a popsicle party meet and greet beginning at 4:30 pm in the Panther Plaza.
- A map of drop-off and pick-up locations is posted on the website.
- Our new start time is 8:00 am with release at 2:45 pm on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Wednesday release time will be 12:45 pm.
- Supply lists are posted on the website. Teachers will provide more detailed supply lists after the first day of school.
- Masks will continue to be optional.
